




ACE Mentors are passionate about what they do and often make significant contributions to their communities as role models, trusted friends and career advisors.

- Meetings occur in schools, mentor offices, or other locations.
- Through hands-on activities, student teams first learn basic skills and knowledge. They apply this to developing realistic projects in second half of program.








PRESENTATION

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



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


JOIN OUR NETWORK.
