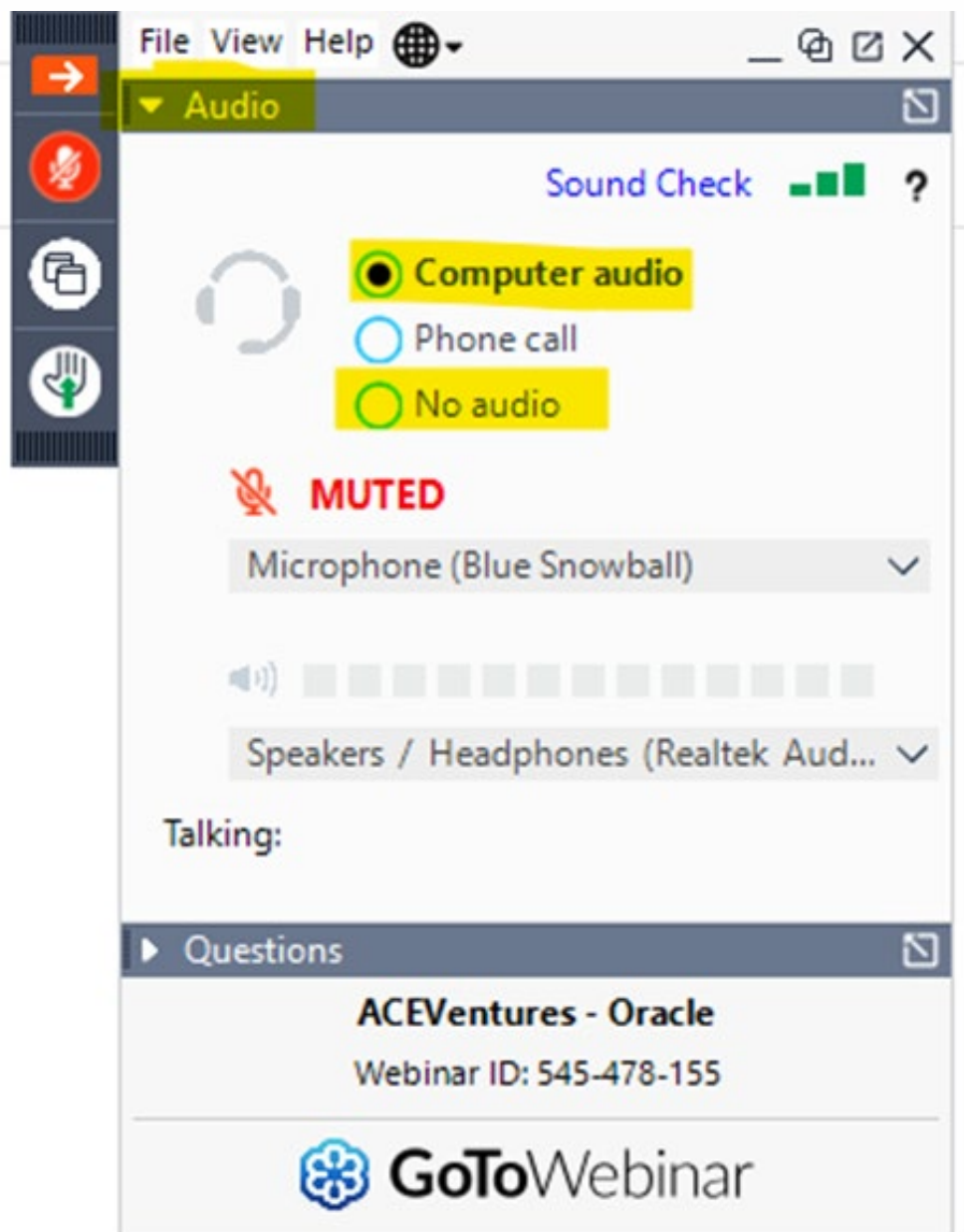
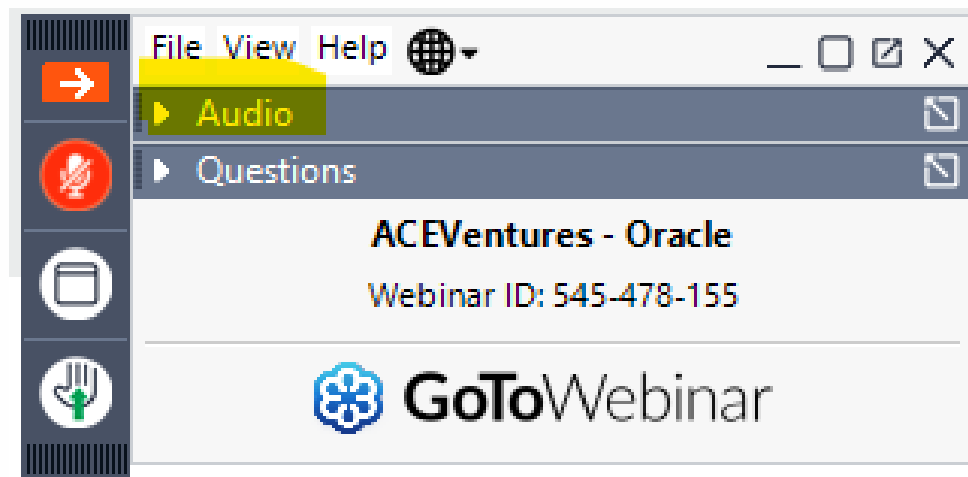

PREFERENCE – CONTINUE VIRTUAL MEETINGS

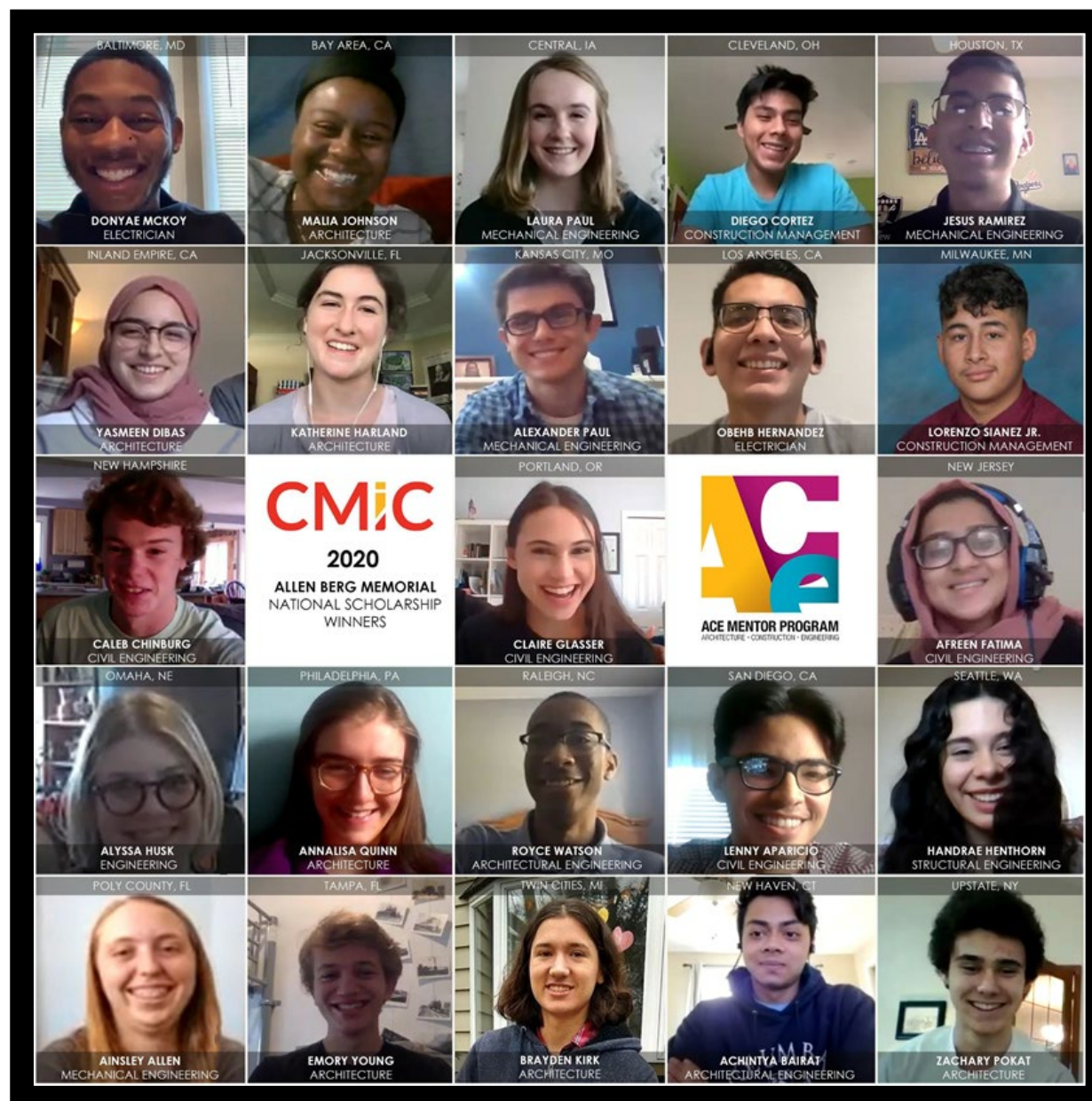

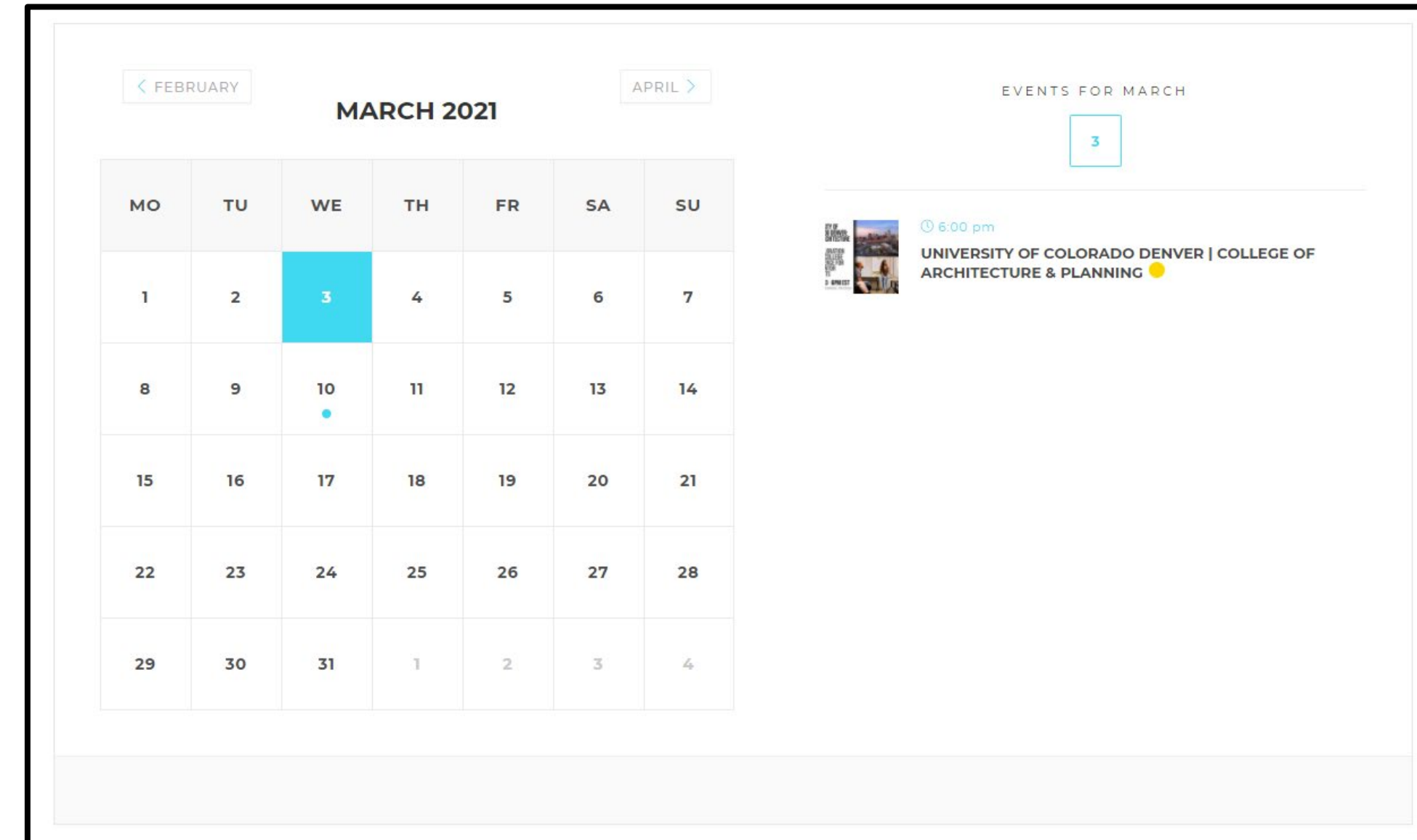
