

ACE Mentor Scholarship

Thomas Jefferson University is pleased to offer the Jefferson ACE Mentor Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to an incoming first-year student enrolling in the College of Architecture & the Built Environment. The recipient must have participated in the ACE Mentor Program.

The scholarship is a \$15,000 renewable* award. Notification of this award will be provided by April 1.

Requirements

- Apply for admission by March 1 to an <u>undergraduate program</u> in the College of Architecture & the Built Environment.
- Meet the <u>admissions requirements</u> for your intended major. ACE Mentor Scholarship eligibility is contingent upon admission to the University.
- Submit a 300-500 word written reflection on the ACE Mentor Program.
 - Essays should be emailed as a PDF to <u>enroll@jefferson.edu</u> with the subject line: ACE MENTOR SCHOLARSHIP.
 - o The following prompts should be addressed in your essay:
 - Why did you decide to participate in the ACE Mentor Program?
 - What has been the impact of the ACE Mentor Program on you?
 - How will the ACE experience affect your future?

^{*}This award cannot be combined with other academic scholarships at the University. Jefferson will conduct a review of your financial aid package each year and apply the highest award amount that you are eligible for.
