

# Fallingwater Institute Residencies and Virtual Summer Camps for High School Students | 2022

Students of the ACE Mentor Program have an exciting opportunity to apply for full and partial scholarships to attend Fallingwater Institute's High School Residency programs.

Designed by Frank Lloyd Wright in 1935 for the Edgar J. Kaufmann family of Pittsburgh, Fallingwater is famous the world-over and attracts thousands of visitors each year. Owned and operated by the Western Pennsylvania Conservancy, it was named the "Best All-time Work of Architecture" by the American Institute of Architects in 1986, a National Historic Landmark in 1976, a Pennsylvania Commonwealth Treasure in 2000, and in 2019 was inscribed to the World Heritage list by UNESCO (United Nations Educational and Scientific Organization).

## SUMMER RESIDENCIES

A limited number of full and partial scholarships available to ACE students. Tuition is \$1,200 per student and includes all meals, housing, and materials but excludes travel. All sessions are held Monday thru Friday.

### STUDIO 1

High School Virtual Summer Camp: **STUDIO 1** is for students in grades 9 through 12 who are curious about careers in design, architecture or the visual arts. Program activities include individual and collaborative projects, drawing, model-making exercises. Led by professional teaching architects, this program provides an opportunity for students to examine and explore Frank Lloyd Wright's ideas.

### STUDIO 2


High School Virtual Summer Camp: **STUDIO 2** is for students age 17 or older who are prepared for admission to an architecture, design or art school. During the five-day intensive skill building program, students will create original, portfolio-worthy work. This course is led by a licensed teaching architect, who will guide studio explorations that are comparable to a first-year studio foundation course, which is a typical requirement in undergraduate programs in architecture, design and visual art. Students will enjoy livestream access to Fallingwater and opportunities for reflective writing and sketching from observation.



### PORTFOLIO PREP

A successful portfolio conveys your creative vision and is an expression of your unique identity and ideas. Learn how to assemble and present a portfolio that communicates your skills, personality, and point-of-view. Spend a week immersed at Fallingwater and its beautiful site while creating original, portfolio-worthy pieces in a collaborative studio environment. This course is for students who are considering college and careers in creative fields. All ability-levels are welcome.




## PORTFOLIO PREP

Get inspired by Fallingwater during this week-long, guided studio exploration. Fallingwater Institute instructors will help you produce portfolio-worthy pieces in the medium of your choice, with a special focus on traditional studio processes and tangible work created by hand. Portfolio Prep is for students who are interested in studying design, architecture and fine art at a collegiate level. All skill levels are welcome. Fee includes basic materials and tools, provided by mail. Streaming-quality internet connection and device with video chat capability required.

## DRAWING BY HAND: Intro to Architectural Drawing

Frank Lloyd Wright's sketches for Fallingwater were created by hand, using pencils, rulers, and scales. Improve your drawing skills and learn the basics of architectural drawing during group discussions, independent studio time, and individualized critique. Fee includes basic materials and tools, provided by mail. Streaming-quality internet connection and device with video chat capability required.
