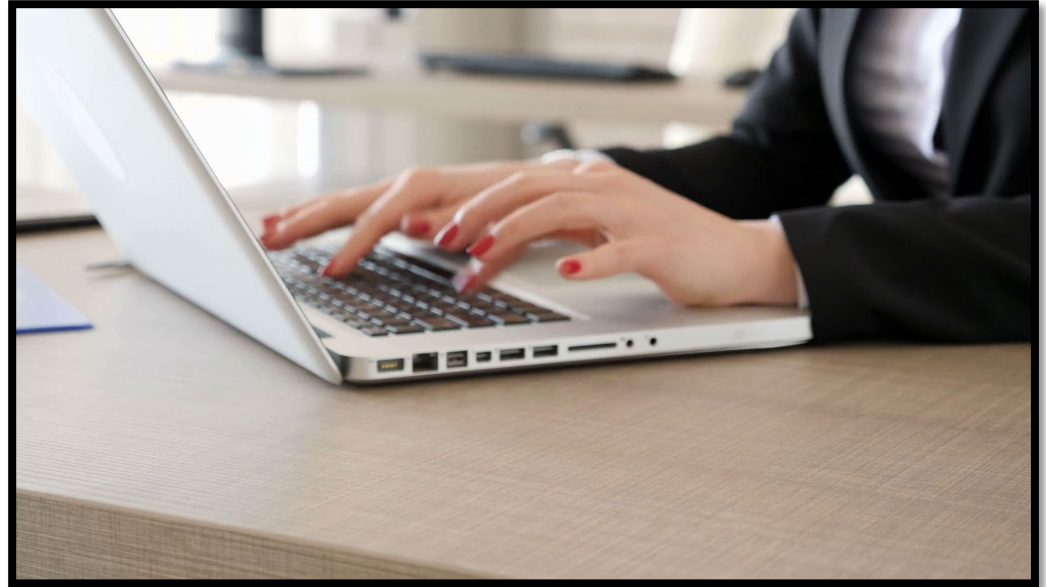



## Denver Summer Camp CONNECTS ACE STUDENTS Across the Country

Summer camps have been an integral part of ACE for a number of years, some local and others national in scope. Unique as the ACE Summer Camp at the University of Colorado Denver. Hosted by the College of Architecture and in conjunction with the ACE Mentor Program, the camp has long been a highly sought-after opportunity for students from across the country. This year, the program opened to all ACE affiliates across the country and Canada.

Led by Leo Darnell, CAP assistant dean of academic services and extended studies and past chair of the ACE Mentor Program, the program accepted 34 students, all interested in architecture, construction and engineering careers, for an all-expenses-paid summer. Students live on campus in the dorms and interact with mentors and professors from CAP as well as the University of Colorado Denver. Activities include 3D modeling, drawing techniques and laser workshops as well as tours and fun excursions.

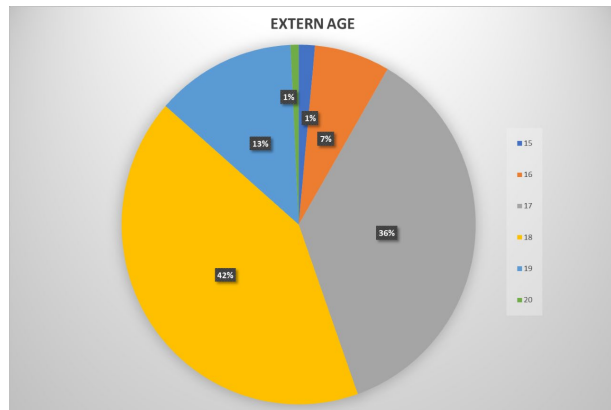

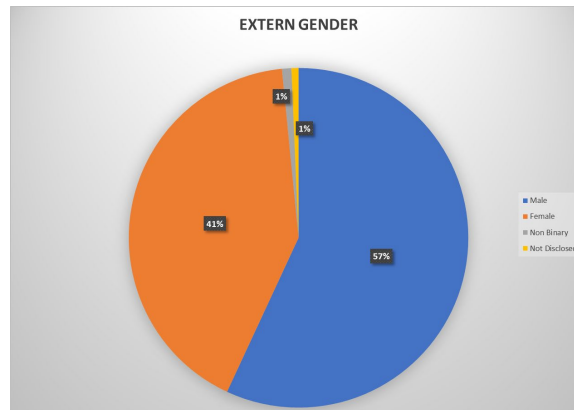

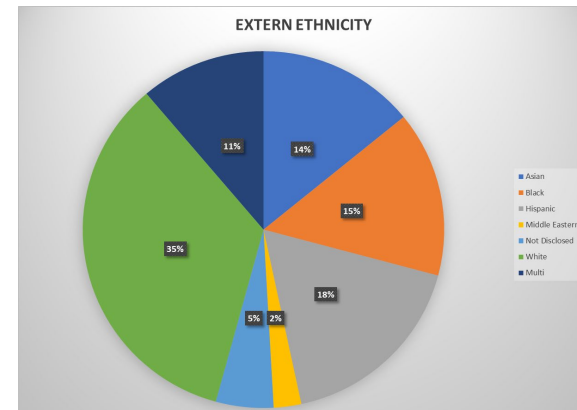
### Summer Workplace Experience Demographics

### Goal of Summer Workplace Experience

To give high school students the opportunity to gain in depth knowledge of the AEC industry outside the ACE traditional sessions

### Suggestions on selection process

1. High School Seniors and Juniors
2. Local Scholarship Winners or separate vetting process

5. Freshman/Sophomore Placements are possible, must follow state guidelines in order to be matched with an externship
