**Join us at Fallingwater this summer!** Students of ACE Mentor Program have an exciting opportunity to apply for full scholarships to attend Fallingwater Institute's High School Residency program.

Designed by Frank Lloyd Wright in 1935 for the Edgar J. Kaufmann family of Pittsburgh, Fallingwater is famous the world-over and attracts thousands of visitors each year. Owned and operated by the Western Pennsylvania Conservancy, it was named the "Best All-time Work of Architecture" by the American Institute of Architects in 1986, a National Historic Landmark in 1976, a Pennsylvania Commonwealth Treasure in 2000, and in 2019 was inscribed to the World Heritage list by UNESCO (United Nations Educational and Scientific Organization).

**Drawing + Model-making** is for students entering grades 9 through 12 who are curious about careers in design, architecture, or the visual arts. Program activities include individual and collaborative projects, drawing, model-making exercises, and drawing sessions in and around Fallingwater. Led by professional teaching architects and artists, High School Residencies provide an opportunity for students to examine and explore Frank Lloyd Wright's ideas while living and studying at Fallingwater's remarkable site.

Thanks to ACE Mentor Program, a limited number of full scholarships are available for ACE students to join this session of Fallingwater Institute High School Residency. Scholarships include tuition only: meals, lodging, and materials. Excludes travel expenses.
