Instructors from the Architecture Department will lead students in an investigation in design, digital fabrication, and sustainability, culminating in the design and fabrication of a final design build project.

Along with working in studio and labs with experienced instructors and engaging with current undergrad and grad students, campers get a glimpse into college life.

DESIGN BUILD PROJECT

Using digital modeling, laser cutters, 3D printers and hand tools, students will be building a project of their design. Past projects have included rooftop furniture, indoor furnishings and installations for the College of Architecture and Planning, outdoor workspaces, vertical cities and more.
