### LIFE AS A COLLEGE STUDENT

Campers will stay in CU Denver's residential hall where they'll experience dorm living, eat meals in the dining hall, and enjoy other campus amenities. Along with working in studio with experienced instructors and engaging with current college students, campers get a glimpse into college life.

### DESIGN PROJECT

Using a variety of materials and hand tools, students will be working in groups to build and present a final project by the end of the week. Past projects have included rooftop furniture, indoor furnishings and installations for the College of Architecture and Planning, outdoor workspaces, miniature vertical cities and re-imagined city spaces.
